



COLORADO CLEAN INDOOR AIR ACT DENVER ENERGY CENTER

Colorado Clean Indoor Air Act

Under this State of Colorado ban, smoking is prohibited in most indoor areas and is not allowed within 15 feet of an establishment's main entryway.

Violators are subject to a \$200.00 fine for the first violation, \$300.00 for the second violation, and a \$500.00 fine for every violation per day thereafter within a calendar year.

Denver Energy Center is taking this one step further. In compliance with our LEED certification, smoking will not be allowed within 25 feet of the buildings' entrances. Signs are located at the entrances with this directive.

There is no smoking, including e-cigarettes, anywhere within the Denver Energy Center including the garage and dock areas.

Additionally, our Security staff will be educating smokers about the restriction and directing them to an appropriate distance from the building.

It is important to remember that the smoking ban was enacted to protect the health of the public and employees, by reducing exposure to second-hand smoke.
